

HARRC Board Meeting Minutes 9 July 2014

The July Board Meeting was held at Brad Colwell's house and was called to order by President Brad Colwell at 7:09 PM. Prior Meeting Minutes:

Treasurer's Report:

Brad Colwell reported the bank balance was \$17,013.54 as of July 9, 2014. HARRC made donations that totaled \$2,100 to various charitable organizations in the recent months.

Membership Report:

Brad Colwell reported that the current household membership is 245, with 301 individual members.

The Membership Report was accepted on a motion by Greene, seconded by Spreha and approved.
